


Background

Existing research has shown that **whilst 41% of technicians are female – just 32% of technical managers are female, including in disciplines where women outnumber men.**

This is a national issue and the programme aimed to equip women technical leaders with skills to close the gap.

Co-developed content and modules with technical input.

Programme Structure



A tailored and bespoke approach for current and aspiring women technical leaders

Cohort-based

- In groups of c.30 delegates. Shared learning opportunities within groups that were designed to maximise diversity in discipline, institution and UK location

Action learning set groups

- To develop closer and more personal delegate relationships. Created a safe space to share specific, and often shared, challenges associated with women in technical leadership

Events

- An online launch event and in-person celebration event of all delegates to create a real sense of community and achievement

The Herschel Programme - Structure

Named after Caroline Herschel, a pioneering 18th century woman astronomer considered an early 'technician' to her brother William

2022 Pilot Programme



The Herschel Programme 2022 Pilot

- Over 170 women from across 55 UK HE and research institutes have completed the programme
- Six-month duration from January to July 2022
- Delegates were in one of 6 cohorts
- Celebration event held on 14 July in London



Action Learning Set (ALS) group poster presentations


All delegates were grouped into smaller ALS groups, 36 in total

Delegates shared their experiences of the programme and their key learning points




Posters were incredibly creative and collaborative and displayed at the celebration event




The significant impact on delegates – comparison of pre and post programme survey responses
